He has attended safeguarding conferences in the UK and Internationally and is a member of the United Kingdom's Governments Child Exploitation and Online Protection Academy. He is currently a member of the Boundary Breaking project at the Centre for Catholics Studies of Durham University. In 2018 Gracewing published is book, "The Burden of Betrayal: Non-offending priests and the clergy sexual abuse crisis." He has recently been seconded by his bishop to work as a Safeguarding Consultant, developing safeguarding practice in the Developing World.
